Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1 and the inherent powers of this Court:


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

Due to the forecast of inclement and potentially hazardous weather and flood conditions, the uncertainties as to the extent of the impact of Tropical Storm IDA, the Declaration of a State of Emergency issued by the Plaquemines Parish Government and acting in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55 (E) (2), the 25th Judicial District Court and the Plaquemines Parish Clerk Of Court's Offices shall close at 3:00 pm on Friday, August 27, 2021, remain closed on Monday, August 30, 2021 and shall reopen at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, August 31, 2021 by authority and order of the Chief Judge.
