- Proper attire is required. Video court appearances are court 1. appearances.
- Any video recording, audio recording, photographing, taking 2. screenshots and/or reproducing of Court proceedings is strictly prohibited.
- Choose a quiet place to participate in the hearing. Cell phones and 3. office phones should be muted, doors to rooms closed and disruptions minimized.
- Participants may not appear from their vehicles. 4.
- Devices should be named properly and include the participant's full 5. name so the Court can identify who is in the online waiting room.
- Attorneys must sign in online before joining the video conference. 6.
